# A WORD FROM THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

## AKEFEMA: Driving Growth and Sustainability in Kenya's Animal Feed Industry

**D**The Association of Kenya Feed Manufacturers (AKEFEMA), registered under Kenya's Societies Act and founded in 2004, stands as the official, unified voice of the nation's livestock feed industry. Our vision is to be the definitive voice of the sector, driven by a mission to cultivate a vibrant business environment that delivers high-quality feedstuffs and related services to all stakeholders. At our core, we exist to promote profitable livestock farming through the production of quality animal feed and the fostering of a conducive business landscape.

AKEFEMA proudly presents the AKEFEMA Feed Exhibition and Conference, AFEC, a one-of-a-kind platform in Africa designed to drive business growth, foster learning, and facilitate meaningful connections. Our mission is clear: to bridge local feed industry players with global experts, sparking knowledge exchange, innovation, and strategic partnerships.

What sets AFEC apart is its unique dual focus on business and science. While other events may offer one or the other, AFEC brings both together to tackle the region's most pressing challenges head-on. Eastern Africa is a rapidly emerging feed market, fueled by rising livestock and human populations, yet it faces critical gaps: severe feed deficits, poor genetics, and low productivity. These challenges, however, are precisely where opportunity lies.

For forward-thinking businesses, these gaps represent a fertile ground for innovation, investment, and long-term growth. Moreover, the region's limited access to quality feed production inputs has created a ripple effect, opening doors for creative solutions and new market entrants. AFEC is where these opportunities are explored, developed, and turned into reality. The future of animal feed in the region is not just emerging; it is waiting to be built.

### The Association

Just as nations are joining together to create regional blocks, and businesses are merging to gain competitive advantages in global and business engagements, AKEFEMA is a unique Association where businesses in competition have organized themselves to gain advantages in business networking, Training, Policy and regulatory matters, and to expand their market together.

To achieve this, AKEFEMA's operations are powered by a robust and thoughtful layered structure. The National Executive Committee (NEC), elected every three years, sets policy direction, translating member resolutions into actionable strategy. Our operational engine runs on five specialized committees: Technical, Trade, Training, Publicity, and Finance & Administration. These committees are laser-focused on their domains, from quality standards with regulators to trade lobbying and member capacity building. To ensure nationwide representation, members are organized into seven regional chapters: Nairobi, Eastern, Mt. Kenya, Coast, Kiambu, South Rift, and North Rift-Western. The Secretariat, which I lead, coordinates the day-to-day operations and implements a four-pillar Members' approved strategy of Policy and Advocacy, Member Value Addition, Self-Regulation and Governance, and Institutional Growth.

Our performance is evidenced by significant and tangible achievements. Through sustained advocacy, we have secured critical policy wins, including year-round duty-free importation of all animal feed inputs and a one-time registration process for feed ingredients with regulators, key measures that have preserved our members' competitiveness. Our commitment to self-regulation is demonstrated through our collaborative work with the Kenya Bureau of Standards (KEBS) to develop and review industry standards, including the AKEFEMA Code of Conduct aligned with KS 2543:2014, ensuring our members produce safe, high-quality feed.

Our achievements are further defined by impactful capacity-building initiatives. Our partnership with the U.S. Grains Council (USGC) has been instrumental, providing specialized training on feed mill management, quality control, and the Code of Conduct to over 180 individuals across Kenya. This partnership, recently renewed, will now offer members the opportunity to attend a regional training center in Tunisia to further enhance their skills. We are also collaborating with higher institutions of learning to produce competent graduates ready to seamlessly integrate into the industry. Additionally, PUM Netherlands, renowned feed industry trainers, are partnering with AKEFEMA to train 60 millers annually for the next three years on Feed

Safety and Good Feed Manufacturing Practices.

**The Main Challenge and Our Strategic Response**

The single greatest challenge we face—and one that keeps many of us up at night—is the chronic inability to guarantee sustainable, year-round access to quality maize and soya at reasonable prices. Kenya produces approximately 2.5 million tons of animal feed annually, yet a staggering 80% of raw materials are imported from neighboring countries. This has created a 60% feed deficit, an annual shortfall of 33 million tons, significantly impacting livestock production and national food security. This heavy reliance on imports exposes the industry to international currency volatility and geopolitical disruptions. In the last year alone, maize and soybean prices have risen by about 30%, forcing many small and medium-sized milling plants to close.

This critical challenge forms the core of our strategic focus. We are actively exploring and promoting alternatives to the traditional maize-soya formulation, including Distillers Dried Grains Solubles (DDGS), Black Soldier Fly (BSF), sorghum, sunflower, and cotton. We are also advocating for the responsible adoption of biotechnology to boost the local production of key raw materials like yellow maize and soybeans. To further stabilize supply chains and reduce costs, we are pursuing a landmark contractual agreement with the Cereal Growers Association that could reduce feed costs by up to 50%.

**Opportunities on the Horizon**

Despite these challenges, the opportunities are immense. The Eastern Africa region, with a population of over 450 million and an annual growth rate of 3%, presents a significant and growing market for animal proteins and, consequently, animal feed. Kenya, with its large skilled labor force and supportive government, is well-positioned to be the leading player in the regional feed industry.

Our landmark AKEFEMA Feed Exhibition and Conference (AFEC) is a testament to this potential. In 2024, the conference brought together over 548 delegates from 19 countries in Nai-

robi, providing a powerful platform for innovation, networking, and business growth. It showcased the latest technologies and addressed industry challenges under the theme “Resilience and Innovation for Enhanced Food Security.”

Our members currently produce an estimated 80% of Kenya’s commercial animal feed, employing up to 80,000 Kenyans directly and 200,000 indirectly. This despite operating at an average of just 65% capacity due to the shortage of critical raw materials. Commercial feed currently serves only 27% of the country’s ruminant population and about 41% of the poultry population. This means a vast number of free-range livestock remain untapped customers, waiting for cost-effective feed solutions.

As the CEO of the Association, I see and work toward the exponential growth of Kenya’s feed industry to meet the rising demand for livestock feed and animal protein. The scale is enormous, and the responsibility is heavy. Whether you are a feed miller, an input supplier, an equipment provider, or a service company, there is a place for you in AKEFEMA. The cake is big enough for all progressive businesses. Let’s support the association to open this frontier for growth.

Our endgame is simple, powerful, and worth repeating: Quality feed for safe food. Because when Kenya’s livestock farmers thrive, the entire food chain wins; from the farm to the dinner table.
